RULES

Every entry at a New Jersey Pony Breeders & Owners, Inc. competition shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that all participants, which include without limitation the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider, handler, trainer, and the pony, for themselves, their principles, representatives, employees and agents:

1. Shall be subject to the Constitution and Rules of the Association and the local rules of the competition;
2. Represent that every pony, rider, and handler is eligible as entered;
3. Agree to be bound by the rules of the New Jersey Pony Breeders & Owners, Inc. pony-show competition, and will accept as final the decision of the management on any question arising under said rules, and agree to hold New Jersey Pony Breeders & Owners Inc., their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken.
4. Agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry they authorize New Jersey Pony & Owners, Inc. and/or the competition management to market, transfer, assign or otherwise make use of the pony(ies) and participant(s) while on the grounds, incident to, or in transit between, the stabling facility, and the event site in any way they see for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the event or sport, without compensation to any of them, so long as the use neither jeopardizes amateur status nor endorses a specific product or service, and hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation;
5. And agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that equine sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk of serious injury or death, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of injury or loss, and they agree to indemnify and hold New Jersey Pony Breeders & Owners, Inc. and their officials, directors, employees, and agents harmless from and against all claims including for any injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees, or agents of New Jersey Pony Breeders & Owners Inc.
